

SAFE PROGRAMS

Housing, Healing & Support Services

Children's Shelter & Teen Parent Program - providing emergency care for children and youth in the child protection/foster care system

Transitional & Supervised Independent Living Programs for Youth - communal living and support services for youth transitioning from foster care to independence, including services for foster care alumni

Therapeutic and Counseling Program - individual and group counseling for people who have experienced abuse

Foster & Adopt - recruiting, licensing & supporting families who foster & adopt children in the child welfare system

Survivor Advocacy - case management and advocacy for adult victims working toward financial stability

Emergency Shelter - emergency shelter for victims of family and/or sexual violence; adults and their children

Supportive Housing Program - transitional living, housing and support for families fleeing violence and homelessness

Children's Services and SAFE School - supporting and educating the children and youth we serve

Family Tree - early childhood program for children who have experienced trauma

SAFE CARES - collaboration, advocacy, response, and engagement of survivors of commercial sexual exploitation of children

Prevention and Community Services

Community Advocacy - working with the other systems that survivors interact with, i.e. courts, law enforcement, etc.

Forensic Nursing & Advocacy/Eloise House - sexual assault forensic nursing & advocacy

Legal Services - representation, free presentations and court accompaniment

SAFE Futures - direct support for families and specialized fatherhood services at the intersection of domestic violence and child welfare involvement

PlanetSafe - supervised visitation & exchange center

Expect Respect® - promoting healthy teen relationships through schools and the Changing Lives® theatre program

Strong Start - comprehensive in-home and community based parenting support for families with multiple stressors

Disability Services - awareness and abuse prevention for individuals with disabilities

Community Education - outreach, life skills classes, training and engagement

Deaf SHARE - abuse prevention for individuals who are Deaf/Hard of Hearing and direct services in ASL

Volunteer Services - recruiting & training those who want to help SAFE
