

Many of the survivors we serve at SAFE are needing to start over in a new home with few personal possessions. And, as a nonprofit, we have a limited budget when it comes to acquiring new office furniture as our staff grows to serve more survivors of domestic violence, child abuse, sexual assault, and exploitation.

Due to extremely limited storage space for furniture, please follow this process if you'd to donate any of these furniture items. All items must be in good condition – something you would still pay for from a resale shop, garage sale, etc. Items must be clean, in working condition, free from animal hair, and from a smoke-free home.

1. Send an email to [inkind@safaustin.org](mailto:inkind@safaustin.org) with pictures and a description of the items so we can assess our current capacity to accept it.
2. **Once approved, you must be able to deliver the items** to the SAFE Warehouse at 1515 Grove Blvd during its open hours (every day from 10a – 4p). We can occasionally make an exception for large office furniture donations, but we typically do not have the staff capacity to pick up furniture. **Please do not deliver furniture without prior approval.**
