### CARES

Direct care, drop-in services, & 24/7 advocacy for survivors of sex trafficking

### Foster and Adopt in Austin

Recruiting, licensing, & supporting families who foster/adopt youth in the child welfare system

### Peer Support and Alumni Services

Inclusive support groups led by people with lived experiences to help survivors, including foster care alumni, heal

### SAFE Futures

Support for families who experience domestic violence & have child welfare involvement

### Therapeutic Services

Individual, family and group therapy, and case management services for youth, adults and families (residential and community based)

### Supervised Independent Living

Communal living and support services for older youth in the foster care system serving young adults as they learn, get their needs met and establish connections for long term success.
