



SAFE's Furniture Needs

Many of the survivors we serve at SAFE are starting over in new homes with few personal possessions. Because storage space is extremely limited, we carefully manage furniture donations to make sure they can be put to immediate use. All items must be in good condition—something you would still pay for at a resale shop or garage sale. They should be clean, in working order, free from animal hair, and come from a smoke-free home.

1. Send an email to inkind@safeaustin.org with photos and a description of the items so we can assess our current capacity to accept it.
2. **Once approved, you must be able to deliver the items** to the SAFE Warehouse at 1515 Grove Blvd during open hours (Tuesday–Friday and the 3rd Saturday of each month, 10 a–4 p). Occasionally, we can make exceptions for large office furniture donations, but we generally do not have the staff to pick up items

Please do not deliver furniture without prior approval, as unapproved donations cannot be accepted and may need to be discarded due to limited storage space or exposure to the elements. When this happens, our operations team must arrange for disposal, which uses resources that could otherwise support survivors and their families, and adds unnecessary waste to local landfills.

Following these guidelines ensures donations can go directly to helping those we serve.
